- Small increase this year
- Primarily raised via fundraisers
- Lowest band fees in LPS
- Fundraisers help keep band fees low

**Scarlet Regiment**

  - Wear shorts & show shirt under uniform
  - Parent tip (Karl) – Buy 3 or 4 pr of socks & keep in a baggie in their garmet bag
  - Uniforms have an inventory # assigned to each student
    - Students should know their # (put in phone or write on back of name tag)
- Band Camp begins Monday
  - Bring the following:
    - sunscreen (Apply & bring)
    - refillable lg jug of water
    - hat preferred
    - lunch (no milk products)
    - sunglasses if wanted
    - ½” 3 ring binder with sheet protectors for music
    - Dots (lg mason jar lids, decorated/covered w/duct tape & numbered 1-12)
    - Athletic shoes required & comfy clothing
  - Emergency contact form mandatory by Monday in order to get on field
  - Foundation provides 2 snacks for camp – frozen fruit am & granola bars pm
    - Donation signups in sign up genius
  - Shade tent provided – adult on site if student care needed
  - 1 hr for lunch (end may include team building, etc.)
  - Music rehearsal after lunch due to afternoon heat
